#### **The topic in its context**

During the incredibly hard times of the German occupation of Greece and of the conditions under which the National Resistance operated, arts and culture continued to flourish, if that is the appropriate word. Literary magazines continued to be published despite severe shortages of paper and the daily press was full of announcements and advertisements of theater and opera performances as well as cultural and literary meetings and presentations.

The War Archive has always aimed to present and explore “societies under pressure and especially the pressure of war “ and not just war in the form of battles and campaigns. In this context we are very lucky to have with us Prof.Ismini Kriari-Katrani to help us explore this fascinating aspect of culture and

expression under pressure, poetry during war.
