The topic in brief

Germany in the outbreak of the war was already the most technologically advanced nation in the world in virtually every area of mechanical and electrical engineering,

aeronautics as well as in chemical engineering. Under the pressure of war these areas advanced even further, especially in aeronautics where Germany was the first country ever to develop jet fighters and bombers as well as (nearly) guided missiles. German physicists got fairly near developing the A-bomb. But more intriguing, German technology diverted into near science fiction areas including flying disks, anti-gravity propulsion and other similarly exotic schemes. The presentation will try to draw the line between wishful thinking experimentation and the reality of war pressures. Nonetheless the actual achievements of the Nazi war machine still remain a sobering thought of what could have achieved had it not been militarily defeated

Mr. Vourliotis is a graduate in mechanical engineering from the National Polytechnic. From an early age he was interested in military and war history and preceded to collect an impressive amount of books, magazines and DVDs on the topic. Since 2000 he has dedicated his time as a researcher and writer on the topic of war and has authored score of articles and two books. He is married with two daughters.
