Re-reading the declaration of Dimitris Glinos «The National Liberation Front (EAM): What it is and what it wants»

Saturday 29 September 2018 at 19.30.The preentation will be in Greek.

The topic

Dimitris Glinos was a respected educator and reformer of the Greek educational system during the 1920s. His progressive and liberal views stamped the early stage of reforms but equally met stiff resistance from conservative quarters especially over the introduction of the spoken language, the «demotic» in education, instead of the completely artificial «puristic» version of modern Greek, which harked back to ancient Greek.

Glinos joined the resistance movement in Greece during the WWII and penned a key document of the aims and plans of the National Liberation Front (EAM). This early declaration is well worth revisiting as it throws light on the period and still forms an essential text on the early days of the resistance.

The Presenter : Kostas Therianos

Kostas studied in the Panteio Univeristy and Philosophy School of the Univeristy of Athens, did postgraduate work at York University in UK and obtained his Ph.D at the University of Crete.

He is working in education, and is author of school texts and books on the sociology oif education. He is a member of the governing council of the Glinos Foundation
