The German occupation examined from the archives of the EAM of Limnos

The island of Limnos participated actively in the resistance against the German occupation, especially within the EAM organization, as a center for the activities of special armed units, spying activities on the German forces and propaganda active enough to cause desertions from the German troops as well as evading conflicts between resistance forces of differing political positions. This unknown

and little researched aspect of the history of Limnos during the WWII will be reviewed and illustrated through the work of Aristeidis Tsotroudis

The presenter

Was born in Limnos and qualified as a dentist at the Athens University Medical School, with postgraduate studies at the University of Birmingham, UK, and worked as dentist since 1965.

Since 1985 he also studied music at an Athens Conservatory where in 1997 graduated in Advanced Music Theory with specialism in Harmony.

He has written and published extensively on the history of Limnos during WWII and under the German occupation as well as in related topics of the period.
